In these regions of Croatia, children are unable to play freely outdoors, endangered by an invisible threat. **Our aim** is to alert the students to the major issues of the mine threat, reduce the invisible danger and raise funds for mine clearance in order to enable children to have a happy childhood. The cost of demining is priced at 7.76 HRK (+ tax) per 1m². This project is designed to embrace numerous integrated days/lessons, community and service events, workshops, project presentations, round table discussions, fairs and cultural events throughout the academic year. The project will be carried out in a close cooperation with the Croatian Mine Action Centre and all collected funds will be donated to the Croatian Mine Action Centre.
